NOTE:

Beginning with students entering the ninth grade in 2016–17, students are required to take the **civics test** that is published annually by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services, as a component of their high school curriculum.

- Students must take the test when taking their U.S. Government course.
- Students will be asked to answer 10 of the 100 questions from the published civics test, selected by the teacher, which may be administered in oral or written format (local decision on format).
- Passing the test is not a requirement, nor is there a minimum score. However, to encourage improved civics knowledge, districts may recognize students who pass the test. Answering 6 of the 10 questions correctly currently comprises a passing grade.

• Students in a class where the test is being administered who entered the 9th grade before 2016–17 are not required to take the test.

• Each public school (including charters) must report the percentage of students required to take the test who scored at or above the passing score to the Education Oversight Committee, who will, in turn, reflect the results on school and district report cards.
