Dear Parents,

The last survey that was sent to you through virtual polling indicated that moving to a four-day school week was the choice of most parents. The overall plan is to give students a greater opportunity to have a one-to-one teaching relationship with his/her teachers so that learning takes place. We listened to your concerns about the difficulty students were experiencing trying to learn virtually, so the decision was made to accommodate the learning styles of our students.

The second nine-weeks began Tuesday, October 27, 2020. Students continue to have only two schedules to use in order to attend school. They are:

- A. Four-day face-to-face/virtual instruction on Friday
- B. Five-day virtual instruction

These are the **ONLY** two schedules that are in place in the district. The two-day hybrid schedule is **NOT** in operation at this time.

Thank you for your cooperation and patience with attending school during these challenging COVID days. We truly want to educate all of our students and we continue to do all we can to keep everyone safe. All personnel and students are required to:

- Wear a mask on the bus and in class
- Social distance
- Use hand sanitizer
- Spray classes regularly
- Stay apart on playground/cafeteria

We have in place:

- Deep cleaning every Friday
- Professional sanitizing of classrooms/school offices/cafeteria
- Masks for students
- Masks for teachers/staff
